The legal obligation for the collection of data results from the law for the prevention and control of infectious diseases in humans (Infektionsschutzgesetz - IfSG) in conjunction with the state-specific regulations of Berlin.

The data recorded here is kept confidential and only used if necessary for the follow-up of infection chains in connection with the Corona pandemic. The data will be stored securely in-house for four weeks and will only be passed on to the responsible public health department upon request.

The data will be deleted or rendered illegible of after a maximum of one month. Only the public health department will receive the data upon request. From that point on, the public health department is responsible for data processing.

You also have the right, on grounds relating to your particular situation, to object at any time to the processing of your personal data on the basis of Article 6 paragraph 1 lit. f) of the General Data Protection Regulation GDPR (data processing based on a balance of interests).

If you object, we will no longer process your personal data unless we can provide evidence of compelling legitimate grounds for processing that outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or if the processing serves the purpose of asserting, exercising or defending legal claims. You also have the right to complain to a data protection authority about the processing of your personal data by us.
